BADMINTON (BOYS & GIRLS)

CBSE RULES OF GAMES & SPORTS (UPDATED) – BADMINTON

The first position winner (Gold Medalist) will participate in National level competition as mentioned in CBSE Games Circular (Latest) 2026.

1. CBSE Inter-School Badminton Tournament will be conducted according to the latest and revised rules of Badminton Association of Indian (BAI) with modifications wherever applicable.
2. Every school can send one team comprising of maximum five players, in Under 14, Under 17 & Under 19 yrs separately in Boys" & Girls" category.
3. All the participants must carry their valid age proof certificate and school / CBSE Board Identity-card.
4. All the matches must be played on indoor courts with proper lighting arrangements.
5. In Team Championship, the order of play shall be: Singles – Doubles – Singles.
6. All the matches that are played on "league basis" – shall be of best of one game of 31 points with change of side at 15 points. The player that reaches first at 31 points, wins the match.
7. All the matches that are played on "knock-out basis" – shall be of best of three games of 15 points each, & a match is won with the difference of 02 points. In case, of 14 – all; the game shall continue; however, the player that reaches first at 19 points wins the match.
8. At Zone Level all the matches will be played strictly on knock-out basis. In case the numbers of teams in a particular age category are less, the championship in that category may be organized on league cum knock out basis.
9. No change shall be permitted in the composition of team from Zonal Level to National Level.
10. The school Organizing Zone level competition shall take a Group Photo of the teams that have qualified to participate in National level competition. The photo shall be signed by the host school Principal and forwarded to the school organizing next level of competition along with the original entry Performa.



11. National Championship will be conducted on League cum knock-out basis for which all the teams will be divided into different pools.
12. At National level, one day of the Championship shall be dedicated exclusively to the Individual Championship.
13. At National level: All the teams reporting may be divided into different pools in such a way that by and large no pool is of less than four teams. From each pool, the two teams emerging on top will qualify to play the knock-out stage matches.

INDIVIDUAL CHAMPIONSHIP (BOYS' & GIRLS') ONLY AT NATIONAL LEVEL

1. In addition to the Team Championship, separate Individual Championship shall also be played at National level on knock out basis.
2. Each team reaching in the Nationals shall nominate one player who shall play singles title in each Age Category separately for boys & girls.
3. In each age group, as per BAI ranking list, the top ten ranking players shall be eligible to play directly at National level in "Individual Championship". However, if any player, ranking in top ten, has played at respective Cluster level Individual Championship, and has lost, shall no more be eligible to participate in Individual championship at National level.

DOUBLES CHAMPIONSHIPS

1. Each team reaching in the CBSE Nationals shall nominate one player who shall play singles, and two players for doubles other than the player already nominated for singles in title in each Age Category separately for boys & girls.

IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS

1. **Opening and Valedictory Ceremony:** Opening Ceremony will be held at **on 29 September, 2026** and Valedictory ceremony approximately at **03:00 pm on 06 October, 2026.**
2. **Participation in March Past is compulsory.** Schools are requested to carry their school flag and students must be in proper sports uniform of their school. Participation in March Past is compulsory, failing which their right to participate can be forfeited.
3. Participation criteria as per the CBSE Rules of Sports & Games 2026-27
4. **Only cluster winning teams (Gold medals) are eligible to participate in CBSE National Badminton championship.)**
5. **Age calculation will be as :**
 - (i) **Under 14 years**
 - (ii) **Under 17 years**
 - (iii) **Under 19 years**
6. Meeting of Coaches and Managers will be held at 7:00 pm on 28 September, 2026.
7. The team member must be instructed to observe discipline, code of conduct and to use the school property with utmost care. In case of any damage, deduction will be made from security deposit.
8. Participating schools are requested to bring attested and duly signed CBSE entry Proforma of the participants and coach/manager.
9. Girls' team should be compulsory accompanied by female coach or manager.
10. The participants need to bring their complete Badminton kit (Racket, shoes, dress, shuttle). Kindly do not touch the materials which are costly and sensitive like- Smart Boards, CCTV Camera, Window glass, Fans, Lights, ACs, admirals etc.
11. Team Coach/Manager will be held responsible for any damage/breakage of any item inside the school premises.
12. Team should report in the court, half an hour before the start of match.
13. It is a No Tobacco/No Smoke /No Liquor/No Drugs Zone, if any illegal material is found, it will have legal consequence.



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14. Avail the lunch/dinner etc. as per the timings without making delay by producing the Coupons.
15. All information regarding Badminton Championship is available in the Control Room.
16. The host School will provide separate accommodations for boys and girls.
17. The team Managers and Coaches are supposed to stay with their teams.
18. The payment for food & staying will be borne by the teams and the payment for that per head per day @ Rs. 500/- shall be deposited in advance at the Account Section.

Host school would require confirmation from School's principal whether the team chooses to avail the lodging facility of Host school or avail self accomodation outside of school.

If the team is availing the lodging facility, then they will have to mandatorily avail the meals facility as well for the whole team. Only vegetarian food will be served.

19. Security deposit of **Rs. 2000/** is to be deposited at the time of reporting which is Refundable.
20. **For safety, security, and identification, an ID card will be issued to every participant & Coaches. The Organising School will charge ₹100 per participant/coaches for the ID card.**
21. The team shall be responsible for their belongings and are advised not to carry costly items with them. The contingent must not put damage to the school property. In case of any damage, the participating team will have to bear the cost.
22. The team officials are requested to complete all the formalities and clear all the payments before their departure.
23. The departing teams are requested to inform four hours prior from their departure to the Accounts Department for clearance of their accounts and for arranging the transport.



DISQUALIFICATION

A player/team may be disqualified/scratched for the following reasons.

1. If the ineligibility of any member of the team is detected.
2. Inclusion of non bonafide student in the team.
3. Misbehavior on ground by participants or accompanying official.
4. Use of abusive language by participants or accompanying official.
5. Misbehavior with Officials/Opponents by participants or accompanying official.
6. Indiscipline at the place of stay by participants or accompanying official.
7. Damaging the school property.
8. Indiscipline during the Opening and Closing ceremonies by participants or accompanying official.

PROTEST

Protest of any nature in connection with the tournament shall be in writing and must reach the Organizing Secretary and CBSE Observer within one hour of the declaration of the result, duly accompanied by a fee of **Rs.1000/- (Rupees One Thousand)**.

Such a protest will be considered by Jury of Appeal, consisting of following:-

- 1. Principal, Organizing School**
- 2. Organizing Secretary**
- 3. CBSE Observer**
- 4. One or two technically qualified People present at the venue**

The parties under dispute may be heard before deciding the issue. In case the protest is uphold, the protest fee shall be refunded to the protesting school otherwise the fee shall be forfeited.

The decision taken by the Jury of Appeal will be final and binding.

The decision, together with full facts of the protest may immediately be reported to the Deputy Director (Sports) CBSE.

MEDALS AND CERTIFICATES

No Participation Certificate shall be given to a player/team that does not play after reporting.

UMPIRES/REFEREES/GAME OFFICIAL

Decision of the game officials is final.



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Payment for Security deposit, ID, Boarding and Food (for the ones who avail Boarding & food) for all 8 days will be accepted both in Cash as well as UPI method on the day of registration. Preferable mode of payment will be Cash.

- Cost of food and stay per head per day Rs. 500/-
- Security Deposit Rs. 2000/- Per School (Refundable). If the security deposit is paid in cash, then the refund will also be initiated in cash. If it is from UPI mode, then it will be refunded to respective school's bank account.
- For safety, security, and identification, an ID card will be issued to every participant & Coaches.

The Organising School will charge ₹100 per participant/coaches for the ID card.

1. CBSE Inter-School Badminton Tournament will be conducted according to the latest and revised rules of Badminton Association of Indian (BAI) with modifications wherever applicable.
2. Every school can send **one team comprising of minimum two players and maximum five players**, in Under 14, Under 17 & Under 19 yrs category separately in Boys" & Girls" section.
3. All the participants must carry their valid age proof certificate and school/CBSE Board Identity-card.
4. All the matches must be played on indoor courts with proper lighting arrangements. Feather shuttlecock should be used, and not the plastic shuttlecock.
5. At Cluster level, there will be Team Championship only. In Team Championship, the order of play shall be: Singles – Doubles – Singles.
6. All the matches that are played on "knock-out basis" – shall be of best of three games of 15 points each. No deuce shall be conducted.
7. At Cluster Level, all the matches will be played strictly on knock-out basis. In case the number of teams in a particular age-category are less, the championship in that category may be organized on league-cum-knock-out basis. This may be decided by the Organizing Committee with consent of CBSE Observer and Technical Delegate. In this case, the semi-finals and finals shall be conducted on the basis of best of three (21-21-21).
8. No change shall be permitted in the composition of team from Cluster Level to National Level.
9. The schools Organizing Cluster level meet shall take a Group Photo of the winner athletes/ teams that have qualified to participate in CBSE national meet. The photo shall be signed by the organizing school Principal & forwarded to the CBSE national organizing school alongwith the complete result.
10. National Championship will be conducted on League cum knock-out basis for which all the teams will be divided into different pools.
- 11. At National level:** All the teams reporting may be divided into different pools in such a way that by and large no pool is of less than four teams. From each pool, the two teams emerging on top will qualify to play the knock-out stage matches.

INDIVIDUAL CHAMPIONSHIP (BOYS' & GIRLS') ONLY AT NATIONAL LEVEL

1. In addition to the Team Championship, separate singles & doubles Championship shall also be played at CBSE National level on knock-out basis.
2. Each team reaching in the CBSE Nationals shall nominate one player who shall play singles, and two players for doubles other than the player already nominated for singles in title in each Age Category separately for boys & girls.
3. Individual singles event and Individual doubles event will be played strictly on knock out basis.
4. A team/ players shall be prepared to play more than two matches on a day. However, the organizing school will try its best to give a gap of approx. two hours between two matches, as far as possible.
5. In each age group, as per BAI ranking list, the top ten ranking players shall be eligible to play directly at National level in "Individual Championship". However, if any player, ranking in top ten, has played at respective Cluster level Individual Championship, and has lost, shall no more be eligible to participate in Individual championship at National level.
6. There will be no mixed double championship at national level.
